### "How can I understand unless someone guides me?"

On October 11, we commemorate Apostle Philip of the Seventy. His life should be a daily inspiration to us who share the Good News with the world.

We first meet Philip in Acts 6, where he is one of the seven deacons elected by the Church in Jerusalem. He is best remembered for an encounter on the road to Gaza, where he heard a highranking Ethiopian official reading the Prophet Isaiah. Philip ran and asked the man if he understood what he was reading. The man replied, "How can I, unless someone guides me?" Then, the Bible says, "Philip opened his mouth, and ... preached Jesus to him" (Acts 8:35). Soon, the man believed and was baptized!

People still ask the Ethiopian's question today: "How can I understand unless someone guides me?" That's why Apostle Philip's example should always be before us. We are commanded to guide others to Divine Truth ... and that's just what you're doing, through your support of OCMC!

Tor 40 years following World ■ War II, Albania's repressive Communist regime kept the small country cut off from the world while it brutally enforced a policy of official atheism.

But Albania's ancient Orthodox Faith could never be completely smothered. In the years since the fall of Communism, your support of the Orthodox Christian Mission Center has been helping Orthodoxy flower in Albania once again!

Last spring, an OCMC mission team traveled to Albania with a special focus on ministry to children and young adults. # African villages hear the Gospel for the first time ever, thanks to you!

Tmagine driving for hours across a dusty, sun-baked desert, Lonly to stop under a lonely tree, apparently in the middle of nowhere. As you get out of your rickety old truck, you're met by a small group of men, some carrying knives or automatic rifles. As intimidating as that might be, you also hear a joyous chorus of voices off in the distance. You know you are welcome!

The members of the OCMC mission team who climbed out of that truck last spring weren't scared. The men were members of the Turkana ethnic group in Kenya and they led the team to a dry riverbed where their entire village had gathered to greet the team with song and dance. Thanks to your generous support, the OCMC has been working with the Turkana since 2007, sharing the Good News and welcoming many of them into the Orthodox Faith. The Turkana gave the team a warm welcome!

On this trip, the team, led by OCMC Executive Director Fr. Martin Ritsimade a point of visiting villages that had never heard the Gospel before. They presented skits of Bible stories, translated for the villagers by Turkana Orthodox priests. Then, everyone broke into small groups to discuss what they'd seen and dive deeper into the Bible message. Special groups for teens, and even for young children, made sure nobody was left out.

The goal was not to win converts, but to plant seeds that can be nourished over time by our Orthodox brothers and sisters among the Turkana. With your support, we will continue to work with, and pray for, our Turkana friends as they grow in faith. Thank you for your partnership!



# In isolated Alaskan villages, Orthodox kids are learning more about their faith

Thanks to you, dozens of Native American children ■ in two remote Alaskan villages learned about Jesus Christ's love for them last summer. It's not easy to get to Kwethluk and Napaskiak, 450 miles west of Anchorage, but your generosity sent an OCMC mission team there with the specific goal of helping young Alaskans experience the joy of Christian love and fellowship.

Seventy-eight children from the two villages participated in summer Orthodox Church youth camps. OCMC team members were there to teach Bible studies, share Gospel-based life lessons, lead craft projects, and much more. There was also plenty of time for team members and kids to worship and pray together.

These Alaskan children have inherited a rich Orthodox heritage and it is vital to help them remain string in the



Faith. So, as the Alaskan people welcomed Orthodox missionaries two centuries ago, their descendants are doing the same today! Thank you for sharing the Gospel, even in the remotest corners of North America!

# Your generosity reaches deep into the mountains of Mexico

Pucked away in remote villages in L the mountainous Mexican state of history, traditions, and creed. Our Hidalgo, about 5,000 members of the Natua and Otomi people, descendants of the Aztecs, proudly call themselves Orthodox Christians.

The villages are incredibly hard to get to, and the priest who serves these believers, Fr. Serafim, can't visit them as often as he'd like. This has him worried. "The people are good, and they have a lot of faith," he says. "We cannot lose them." That's why priest and people alike are so happy to welcome the OCMC mission teams you send several times a year!

Team member Hannah Valentine explains that the villagers "have

little knowledge of the Church, its team's goal was simple enough: to lay a foundation for the faithful so Fr. Serafim has something to build upon."

Every morning of their visit, OCMC team members led village children in activities designed to help them understand the Divine Liturgy and the Orthodox Faith, while filling their hearts with Christian love and fellowship. As team member Fernando Arango remembers, "The children happily participated, and their eyes shone like the heavens. It was like the Holy Spirit filled all of us with joy." Thank you for helping
