

"The vision of expanding missionary training as the Church in Alaska matures from a 'receiving field' to a 'sending field' is catching on," Fr. David says. "We are moving in the right direction," he adds, and you're helping make it happen!

Meanwhile, Matushka Rozanne Rucker has become Clinical Supervisor of the Parenting with Love and Limits (PLL) program at the Kodiak Area Native Association. This ministry provides children, adolescents, and their families with counseling and other services. "We have learned that by choosing to cooperate instead of argue, we can help our whole family get better," one graduate of the program says. "Now we have tools to communicate in a healthy way," another says.



Through your support, Orthodox clergy recently gathered for a conference focused on liturgical and pastoral training and services have begun at a new parish church in Kisumu. cooks food for homeless people who attend Alcoholics Anonymous through the St. Dimitrie Program.

And that's not all. "Elena was cradle Orthodox," Floyd says, "but was not attending an Orthodox church.

Today she has returned to the Orthodox Church and is a committed Orthodox Christian."

Floyd wants you to know "I am not alone over here!" Your gifts also support the Protection of the Theotokos Family Center, which provides daycare and other services for families in Cluj. "They have helped over 250 families stay together while the mothers found work or went to vocational training," he says. Floyd adds, "Many of these mothers see the Church playing an important role in their lives in very difficult times. We have brought some of them back into the Church, and even baptized a few kids along the way!"
