An annual report from the Orthodox Christian Mission Center for the fiscal year 2020 to 2021


hroughout the later half of 2020 and the beginning half of 2021, the important work of missions continued even though the world was still reeling from the COVID-19 pandemic. New missionaries began their terms of service in Europe, teams continued their virtual outreach around the world, and more mission priests in Africa received financial support than ever before. The impact of your support of OCMC resulted in the following in 2020/21:

In fiscal year 2020-21 we learned to adapt as the world locked down from the COVID-19 pandemic. Our missionaries stayed with the people they were called to serve, ministering in new ways.
